
We understand that moving countries can be both exciting and overwhelming. That's why we work closely with families and relocation agents to ensure a smooth, welcoming transition into school and London life.


About Knightsbridge School

01 Enquiry

Submit an enquiry via our website or email admissions@knightsbridgeschool.com. We will respond quickly



02 Book a visit or call

We encourage you to book a tour of the school if you are in the UK. Alternatively, our registrar would be delighted to arrange an online meeting to help you learn more.



03 Apply

We will copy of your child's school report as wa erence from their current school.



04 Assessment/ interview

Depending on your child's age, we may invite them for an assessment and an interview with a senior member of staff



05 Offer & Visa support

We will check all visas are in order. If your child is accepted, an offer letter will be issued and you have three weeks to accept or decline.

We provide individualised support to help children from different academic systems adapt quickly. The UK education system is structured into stages based on age and development. At Knightsbridge School, we guide pupils through the Early Years, Primary, and Secondary phases:

- Early Years, ages 3–5:**
 Nursery and Reception classes focus on social, emotional, and foundational skills through the EYFS curriculum.
- Primary Education (Juniors), ages 5–11:**
 Children follow Key Stages 1 and 2, studying core subjects like English, maths, science, and humanities.
- Secondary Education (Seniors), ages 11–16:**
 Pupils work through Key Stages 3 and 4, concluding with GCSE exams in Year 11. These include core subjects and a choice of additional options like languages, art, or history.
